6" Black Ash, South 2° East, 7 links (4.62 ft.)

No resurvey information was obtained for this corner.

In March 1985, the DNR Bureau of Engineering traversed to the area of the corner and searched for but did not find the wood post or bearing trees marked by the GLO. Computed a lost position for this corner using the northeast corner of Section 36 and the east quarter corner Section 24. Lost position was found to measure:

5085.19 ft. from the northeast corner of Section 36 2819.25 ft. from the east quarter corner of Section 24

In July 1985, searched at the lost position and found it to be at top of Lake bank, 10 ft. south of water's edge. No evidence of the corner was found.

Accept the lost position as the location of the corner.
