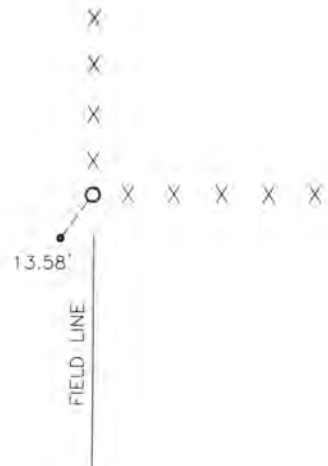

Statement of Evidence

In 1861, L.G.M. Fletcher did the original subdivision of the township.

On May 1, 1931, County Surveyor, a stone was found on the north side of an 8" corner fence post.

On February 5, 1934, F.A. March, found a stone on the north side of an 8" corner fence post with 2 other stone above it.

On September 30, 1974, (No name) a large field stone was found at the center of Section 9-108-41.

On May 30, 2002, Gerald Vickerman found a stone at the center of Section 9-108-41. He did not accept the stone and set an iron T-bar with seal #12237 using a mathematical calculation. It is 4.52' west and 12.80' south of the stone.

On September 6, 2017, Bueltel-Moseng Land Surveying found a T-bar with seal #11237 and a stone using the distances recorded by Vickerman. We did not accept the T-bar as the corner and held to the location of the stone as the center of Section 9-108-41. The stone is at the corner of the occupation lines to the north, south, and east. There is no occupation line to the west. We set a 5/8" iron with seal #43844 on the north side of the stone.
