



East Quarter Corner of Section 12, Township 107 North, Range 40 West

The DNR Bureau of Engineering contacted the following for survey information:

Secretary of State's Office  
Murray County Recorder's Office and Highway Engineer's Office  
Chicago and North Western Railway Office in St. Paul

- 1861 U.S. General Land office notes obtained from the Secretary of State's Office show the corner marked with a wood post and a charred stake in a mound of earth and sod with trench and pits as per instructions.
- 1991 May, The DNR Bureau of Engineering located an east-west fence in area of corner. Also, found an 8' by 8' by 2' high mound in area. Dug a 3.5' by 3.5' by 32" deep hole in center of mound in search of a monument but were unable to find anything. Computed a position for corner as follows:  
on the east-west fence  
on line between the northeast corner of Section 12 and the east quarter corner of Section 13
- The computed position was found to be:  
2644.90 feet from the northeast corner of Section 12  
5277.74 feet from the east quarter corner of Section 13  
4.02 feet south of the lost position for corner

Analysis of the above information led the DNR Bureau of Engineering to conclude that the computed lost position on the east-west fence marks the location of the corner.
