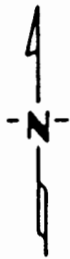

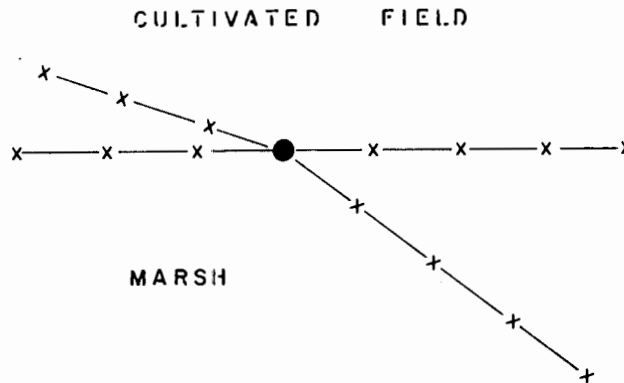

East Quarter Corner Section 14, Township 107 North, Range 40 West

This corner was originally established by the U. S. General Land Office in 1861. The government notes show the corner is in a marsh with a witness corner set 1.00 chain North and marked with a wood post and set in mound of earth with pits and trench dug around the mound.

In March 1985, the DNR Bureau of Engineering contacted the Murray County Offices of the Recorder and Highway Engineer for corner information.

The following information was obtained from the DNR Bureau of Engineering's Office:

A 1964 survey shows that a department monument was set for corner at the intersection of fences east, west, and south. Corner is shown 2643.76 feet from the southeast corner of Section 14.

On July 10, 1985, the DNR Bureau of Engineering traversed to the area of the corner and found a department monument next to a corner fence post with fences east, west, southeast, and west-northwest. The monument was found to be:

2645.60 feet from the southeast corner of Section 14
2612.87 feet from the northeast corner of Section 14
20 feet north of the edge of a marsh

Accept the department monument as the location of the corner.
