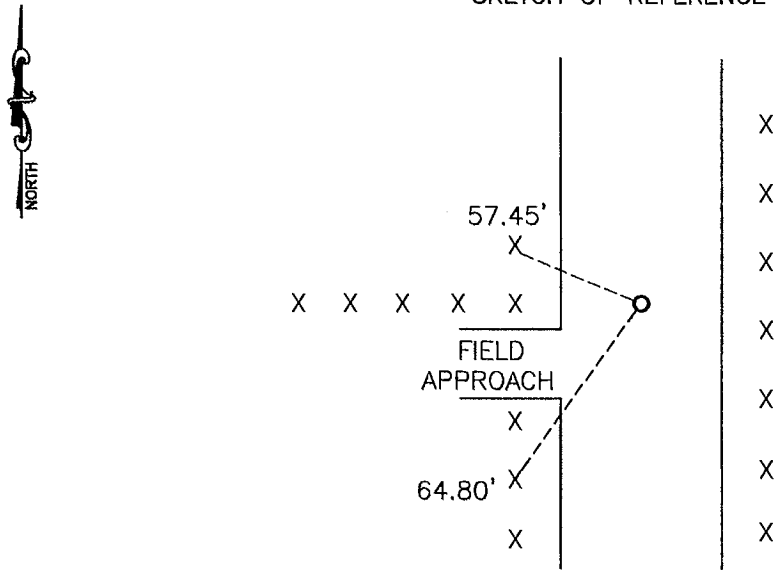

Statement of Evidence

In 1866, J. W. Bishop did the original subdivision of the township.

On June 19, 1913, a stone was recorded at the corner.

In 1936, a concrete marker was recorded at the corner.

In 1940, a concrete marker was recorded at the corner.

On October 21, 2008, Bueltel-Moseng Land Surveying dug with a backhoe. We found a 6" round concrete monument with an "X" on top 7" below the road surface. We placed a $\frac{5}{8}$ " iron with seal #43844 on the north and south side of the monument.
