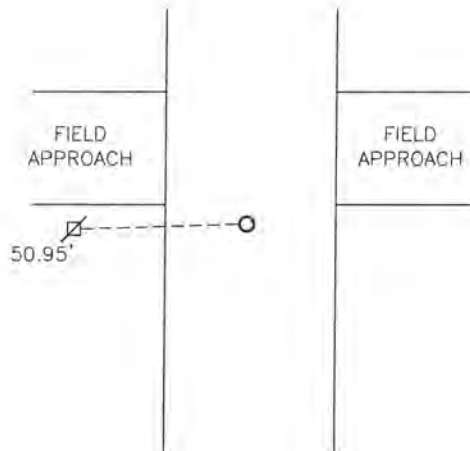

Statement of Evidence

In August, 1861, Wellman and Smoot did the original subdivision of the township.

On June 24, 1913, J.W. Woolstencroft recorded the corner to be equal distances between section corners.

(No Date), Murray County Highway Department plans shows stationing to the corner.

On November 8, 2008, Zieske Land Surveying located an iron monument at the corner.

On October 14, 2015, Bueltel-Moseng Land Surveying set a survey spike with seal #50343 by using Zieske coordinates. It is within 1' of distance from the southeast corner of Section 17-106-39 as shown on Murray County Highway Department plans. It is 1'± west of centerline of road and in line with fence of west side of Section 17.
