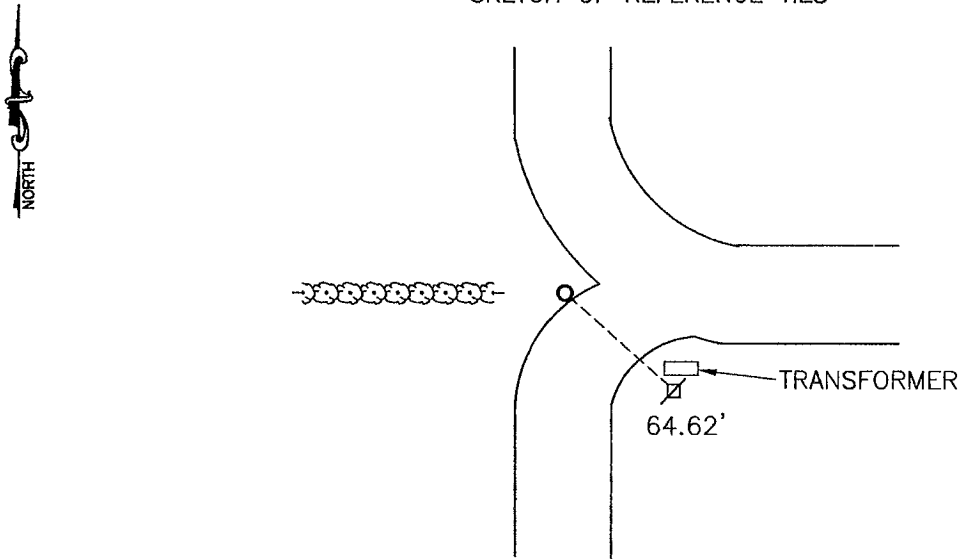

Statement of Evidence

In 1861, L. S. M. Fletcher did the original subdivision of the township.

The Murray County Highway Department recorded a stone and hub at the corner.

On April 22, 2008, Bueltel-Moseng Land Surveying dug with a backhoe. We found a large pointed field stone and 2"x2" hub 3 feet below the surface. It is in line with the centerline of the roads to the north, east, and south and in line with a hedge line to the west.
