

Duane A. Bonnema, LS Reg. No. 14895, found a 7 inch x 9 inch x 6 inch field stone 3.5 feet below the road surface. He placed a Minnesota Department of Transportation Cast Iron Monument near the road surface. This stone is 7 feet South of proportionate measure position based on 1861 original survey dimensions. A hole was dug which extended 2 feet West, 4 feet East, 4 feet South, and 8 feet North of this corner position, however no additional

evidence was discovered.
