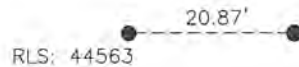
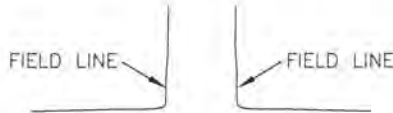

Statement of Evidence

In 1866, J.W. Bishop did the original subdivision of the township.

On November 20, 1925, J.W. Woolstencroft set a pipestone granite rock in the old corner.

On March 23, 2006, Ulteig Engineers, Inc., set a 5/8" rebar with cap RLS 44563 in center line of the road and 22'± west of fence to the south.

On August 31, 2016, Bueltel-Moseng Land Surveying dug with a backhoe in the center of the road and in line with fence to the south. We found a pipestone granite rock and wooden stake on the southwest side of stone. We set 5/8" iron with seal #43844 at the surface of road.
