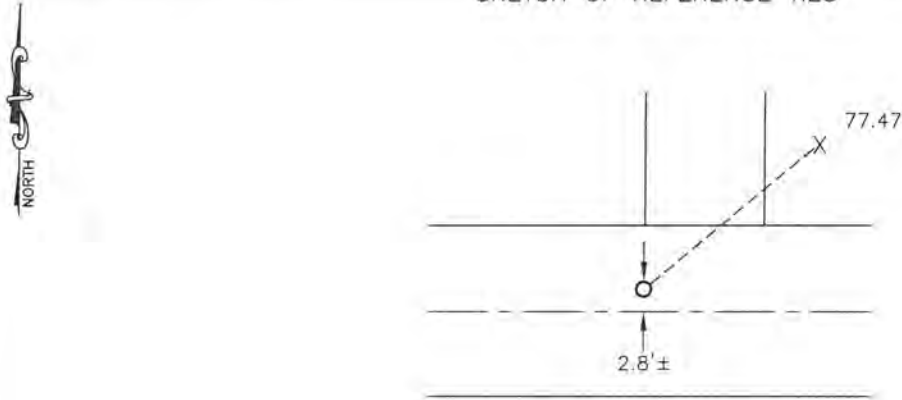

On March 2, 1998, Zieske Land Surveying shows a found monument at the corner as per MnDOT Highway plans

On August 31, 2015, Bueltel-Moseng Land Surveying set a survey spike with seal #43844 by using the MNDOT Highway plans. It is on the west side of a field road to the north and it is 2.8'± north of the centerline of the road.
