

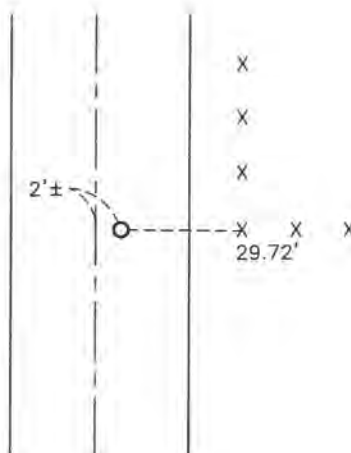

Statement of Evidence

In 1866, J.W. Bishop did the original subdivision of the township.

On June 18, 1913, J.W. Woolstencroft distances were recorded across the north line of Section 9-105-43.

On May 15, 2014, Bueltel-Moseng Land Surveying dug with a backhoe and found a concrete block. It is in line with fence to the east and $2' \pm$ east of centerline. We set 1" pipe with seal #43844 over block.
