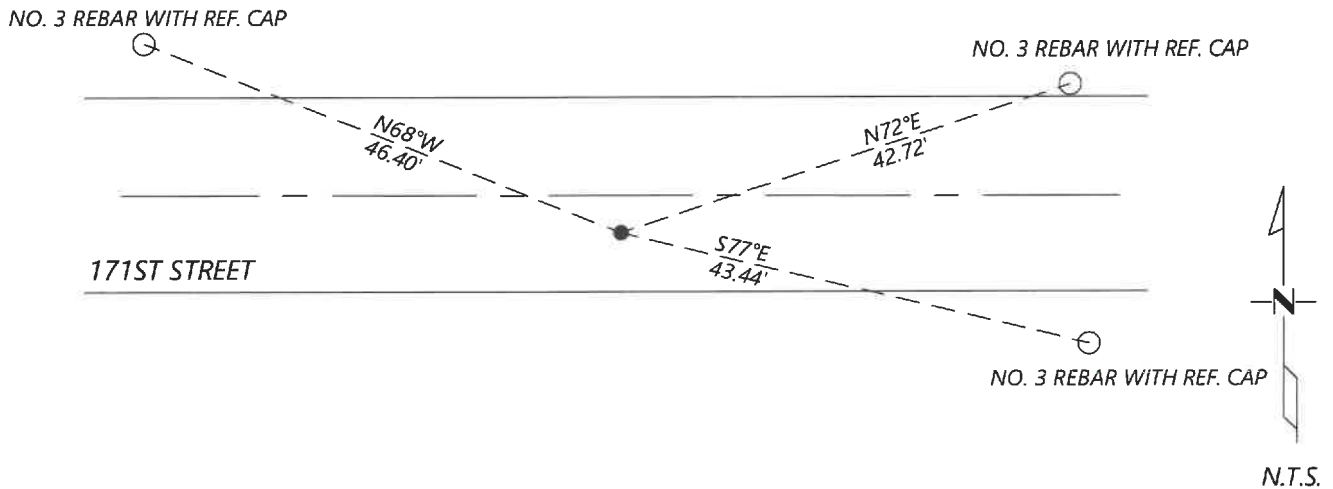

2016 May, Highway Department data shows that nothing was found with a metal detector at the corner.

2019 December, A survey in Section 9 by Jesse Zeig shows that he set a $\frac{1}{2}$ " iron pipe at the corner.

2020 September, Westwood Professional Services searched and found an iron with cap LS #44996 at the corner. I accepted the found monument and set reference ties.
