- 1854 U.S. General Land Office notes, obtained from the Secretary of State's Office, show the corner in a lake so a monument was NOT set to mark its location.
- 1958 Ties to government corners, obtained from the County Highway Engineer's Office, show a concrete monument at corner, but does not indicate if it was found or set. The following ties are shown to corner:

nail and cap in fence post, southwest, 49.9 feet nail and cap in fence post, west, 37.9 feet

- 1967 August 18, the DNR Survey Unit found a stone with a "X" on top, 1 foot above the ground and 0.5 of a foot below the present water surface. The following is noted about corner: no one knows how the stone got set, but it has been there a number of years – original survey shows this corner in lake
- 2002 July 18, A Certificate of Location of Government Corner for the Southwest Corner of Section 9, obtained from B & G Land Surveys, Inc., and signed by Gerald Vickerman, LS 12237, shows that a stone was found down 4 feet near the level of old lake reeds as indicated by old records. An iron T bar was set over the stone and the following ties were taken:

on the center line of an east-west road (221 Street) northerly post of low maintenance sign, west-southwest, 57.7 feet yield sign post, west-northwest, 75.7 feet

St. sign post, west-northwest, 81.4 feet

The following Statement of Evidence is written about the corner:

Original survey did not set this corner but did position its location by offset.

May 1931 survey by F.A. Marsh established this corner on line of NW Cor and W 1/4 Cor at 2640 feet from the W 1/4 Cor. He placed a 12x12x20 stone for the corner. Lake apparently had receded.

Appears to have been used again in 1934 with ties taken. Ties gone.

On 7-18-2002 we dug for SW Cor Sec 9 at center line of gravel road. Dug thru 9"-10" of rocks and gravel then thru black dirt for 3 + feet. Found a large stone at 4 feet down at a point level with crushed reeds. Top of stone just above reed level, bottom unknown as water was seeping into hole

Accepted as corner stone, tied out and set an iron T bar over stone at ties.

2002 June 03 July A Certificate of Survey in Section 9, obtained from B & G Land Surveys, Inc., and signed by Gerald Vickerman, LS 12237, shows that a section corner was found at corner. The corner is shown:

2644.99 feet from the west quarter corner of Section 9 2650.34 feet from the south quarter corner of Section 9

2003 December 16, the DNR Division of Lands and Minerals found a "T" bar down 0.3 of a foot at corner. Searched for and found record ties as shown on sketch of reference ties.

Accept the "T" bar, which was set over a stone, as the location of the corner as established in 1931.
