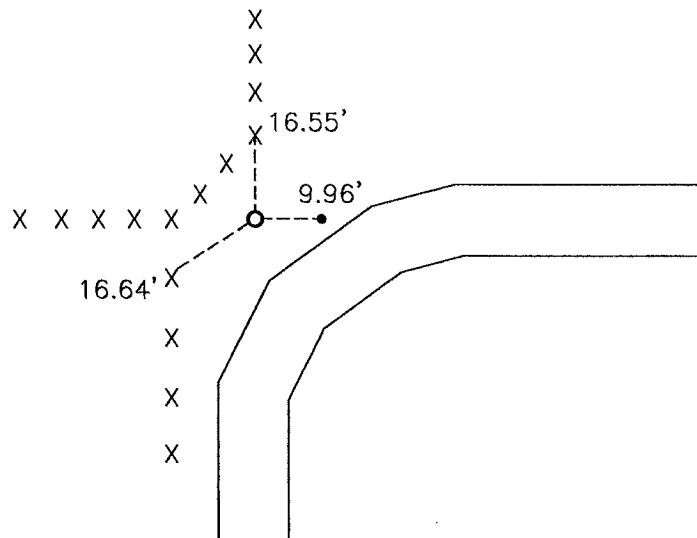

Statement of Evidence

In 1866, J. W. Bishop did the original subdivision of the township.

On June 28, 1911, a stone in mound and 4 pits was set at the corner.

On August 10, 2006, a $\frac{1}{2}$ " pipe with seal #42604 was set 0.3' below surface.

On October 21, 2008, Bueltel-Moseng Land Surveying dug with a backhoe and found a 10" red stone with the remains of the old corner fence post $2'\pm$ below the surface. We also found a $\frac{1}{2}$ " pipe with seal #42604. We held to the stone and set a $\frac{3}{8}$ " iron with seal #43844 on the north side of the stone. We also set a 1" pipe with seal #43844 at the surface. It is at the intersection of the fence to the north and west.
