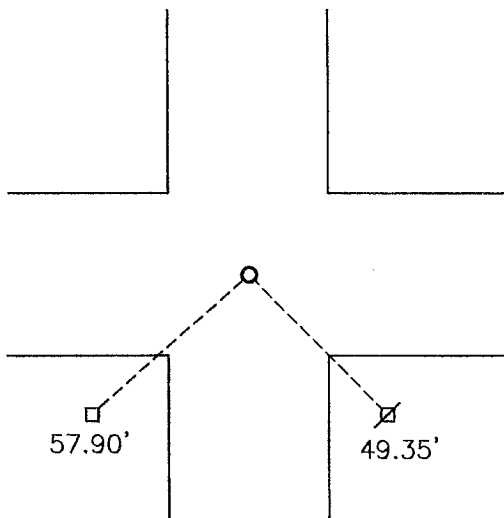

## Statement of Evidence

In 1866, J. W. Bishop did the original subdivision of the township.

On June 19, 1913 a stone was recorded at the corner.

On October 21, 2008, Bueltel-Moseng Land Surveying dug with a backhoe and found a 6" round concrete monument 7" below surface. We placed  $\frac{5}{8}$ " irons with seal #43844 on the north and south sides of the monument.
