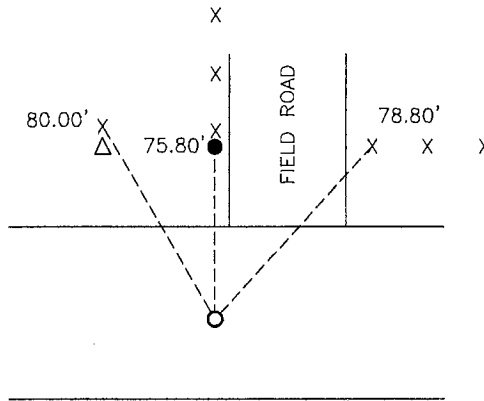

Statement of Evidence

In 1861, L. Brockmann did the original subdivision of the township.

No Date, MNDOT plans show the corner 0.80' south of center of road.

On March 2, 1998, Zieske Land Surveying detected a metal signal 0.80' south of centerline of the road as per MNDOT plans.

On January 4, 2005, Zieske Land Surveying found monument at the corner.

On December 2, 2013, Bueltel-Moseng Land Surveying set a survey spike with seal #43844 by projecting line from east quarter of Section 16 through Zieske found pin on north side of road right-of-way and going south the recorded distance of 75.80' from said pin. It is in line with fence to the north and 1'± south of painted centerline.
