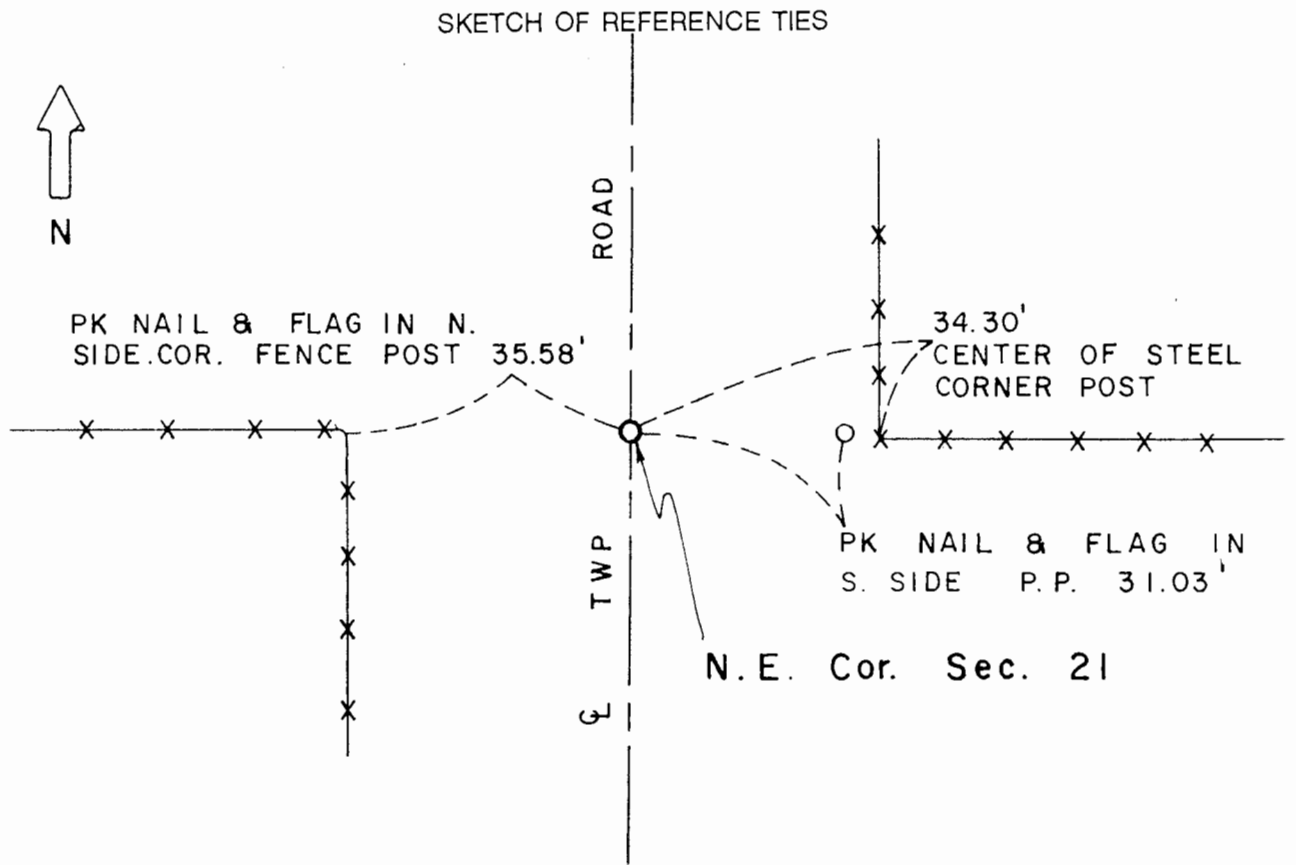


CERTIFICATE OF LOCATION OF GOVERNMENT CORNER

Statement: June 9, 1989 - Found a 1/2 inch Capped Iron Re-Rod at the surface with two small stones below it at a depth of two feet. Lowered the monuments and placed a Mn/DOT Cast Iron Monument above them.

Statement:

July 11, 1861 Original Government Land Office Survey by L. G. M. Fletcher.

June 9, 1989 Duane A. Bonnema, LS Reg. No. 14895, found a 1/2" x 24" iron rod at the road surface with a plastic cap marked "BELL" which was placed by Timothy Bell, LS Reg. No. 16093, from Worthington, Minn. A 7" x 6" x 5" and a 3" x 6" x 6" field stone were found 2 feet below the road surface. Original ground was at a depth of 3 feet and the bottom of the original topsoil was found to be at a depth of 4 feet. The iron rod and two stones were placed 3 feet below the surface and a MnDOT cast iron monument was placed at the road surface.
