

Fletcher records in his field notes, "built mound with

trench pits, charred stake, per instructions."

May 25, 1989 Duane A. Bonnema, LS Reg. No. 14895, found a 6 inch x

12 inch x 12 inch stone 6 inches below the road surface, with a 3 inch x 6 inch x 18 inch stone below it 1 1/2 feet below the road surface. This stone had a wooden stake on the east side of it. Dug 3 feet further down

but no additional evidence was recovered. A Minnesota Department of Transportation Cast Iron Monument was placed

near the road surface.
