Northeast corner of Section 24, Township 106 North, Range 42 West, 5th Principal Meridian, Murray County, Minnesota.

- 1861 J.W. Myers, U.S. Deputy Surveyor, during the original public land survey a wood post was set, deposited charcoal and built mound of earth with trench and pits.
- 1901 J.W. Woolstencroft, survey shows a stake marked by previous survey.
- 2021 Westwood Professional Services searched the area and did not recover a monument. Lines of occupation consists of a North/South and East/West gravel roads. Holding the intersection of road centerlines—as best available evidence of the corner location. The position agrees within reason of a computed lost position along the range line. Set a 1/2" x 18" rebar with a cap marked "RLS 57085" and established 3 local reference ties.
