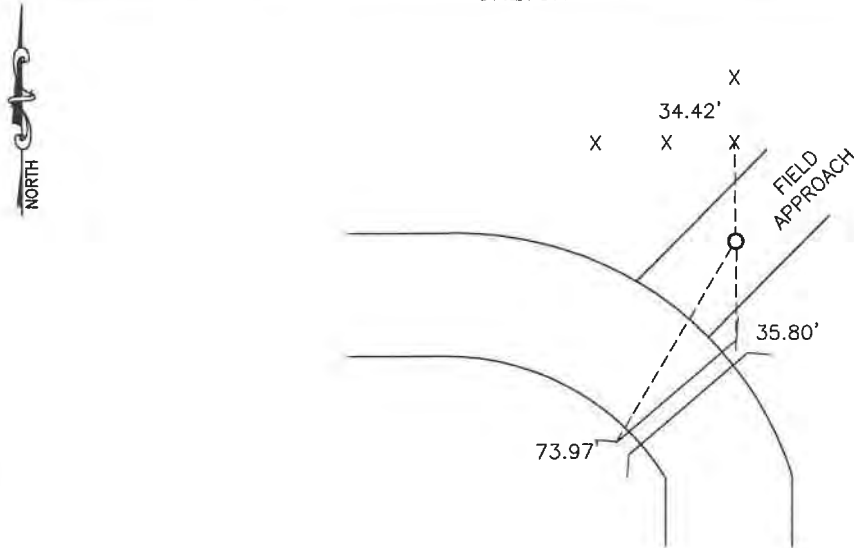

## Statement of Evidence

In 1861, J. W. Myers did the original survey of the west line of the township.

In 1913, a stone was recorded at the corner.

On September 26, 1972, a stone was found at the corner and ties recorded.

On April 30, 2014, Bueltel-Moseng Land Surveying dug by hand, probed a large area and found nothing. Set 1" pipe with seal #43844 using recorded ties from 1972 survey. It is in centerline of road to the south.
