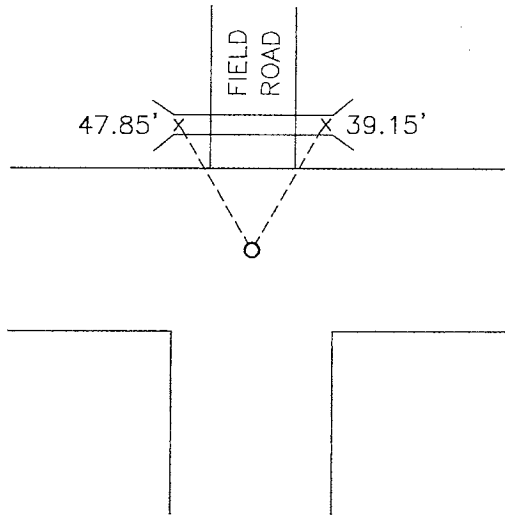

Statement of Evidence

In 1861, L.G.M. Fletcher did the original subdivision of the township.

On June 4, 1907, J. W. Woolstencroft recorded a stone at the corner.

In 1936, the Murray County Highway Department placed a concrete monument with an iron over it.

On April 7, 1970, the Murray County Highway Department found a field stone 2'± below the road surface. They set a 12" bolt above the stone.

In April, 1972, the Murray County Highway Department found a concrete monument at the corner. They set a steel pin above it.

On May 26, 1989, Duane Bonnema, #14895, found a concrete monument over a 12" bolt over a field stone with many other smaller field stones below it. He set a MNDot cast iron monument over the monuments.

On July 8, 2010, Bueltel-Moseng Land Surveying found a PK nail at the road surface. It fits the ties from the Bonnema survey. We removed the PK nail and set a survey spike with seal #43844.
