

Statement:

August 1861

Original Government Land Office Surveyor L. G. M. Fletcher records in his field notes, "built mound with trench pits, charred stake, per instructions."

April 25, 1905

J. W. Woolstencroft, County Surveyor, records in the County Surveyor's Record Book, page 188, "Government stake." He also shows that he measured to the Corner while he was doing survey work in Section 26.

1932

The Minnesota Highway Department records in their field notes, "Sec. Cor./Brass Plug In place." The symbol shown indicates they may have found a stone. They note that this corner is located 0.5 West of the centerline tangent.

Aug. 30, 1989

Duane A. Bonnema, L.S. Reg. No. 14895, removed 4 inches of asphalt pavement and found a 3/4 inch brass rod which had been drilled into the old concrete road surface by the Minnesota Department of Highways in 1932. Further digging was hampered by the old concrete road pavement which contains an abundance of steel reinforcing rod. The brass rod appears to be the best available evidence of the section corner location.
