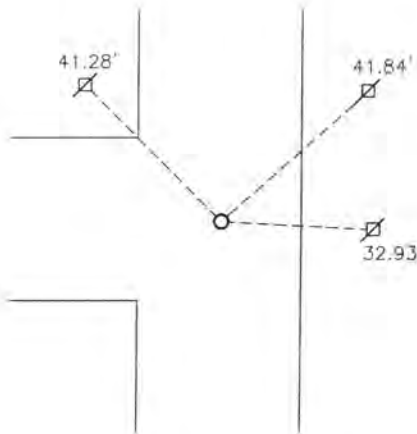



In 1866, J.W. Bishop did the original subdivision of the township.

On August 24, 1901, (No name) County Surveyor, found a stone at the corner.

On April 8, 1980, Gary Martin found a stone at the corner. He set a 3/8" iron with seal #12967 over the stone.

On March 31, 2017, Bueltel-Moseng Land Surveying found a 3/8" iron with seal #12967 at the corner.
