

Statement of Evidence

NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 14, TOWNSHIP 108 NORTH, RANGE 40 WEST, 5TH P.M.

October 1861:

Luois Brockmann, Deputy Surveyor, set a post with pits and mound for corner.

June 18, 1971:

County Corner Index Reference Notes indicate an Iron Pipe was found. Set steel pin above pipe, flush with bit.

April 1972:

Note on Murray County Highway Department construction plan reads:

Located Original Stone 7" below grade. Placed Iron Pin above.

April 04, 1991:

County Corner Index Reference Notes indicate a steel pin was found flush with bit.

April 7, 1992:

County Corner Index Reference Notes indicate a PK nail set above pin, flush with bit.

July 2004:

Isaiah Reicks, Yaggy Colby Associates, found a PK nail flush with bit.

An analysis of the record and survey data indicates the steel pin below the PK nail was set by obliterated methods. It is accepted as a perpetuation of the Public Land Survey.
