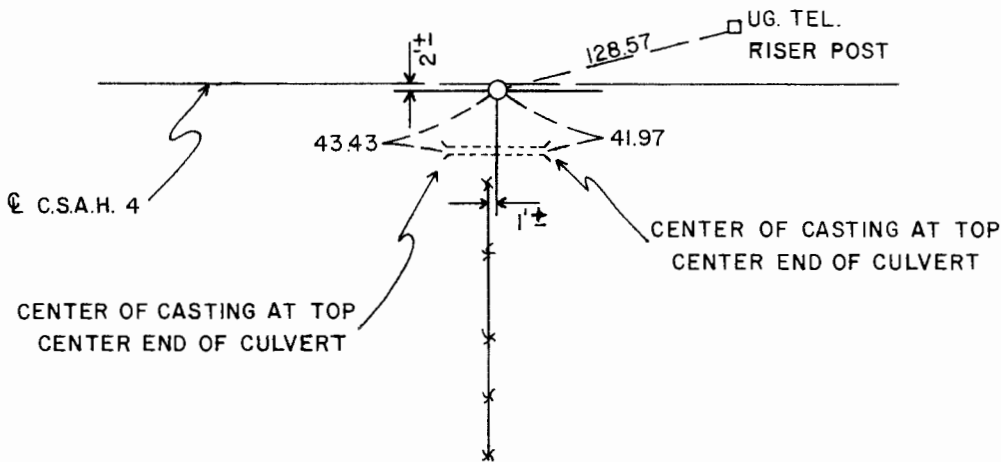
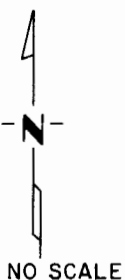

Subsequent Resurvey - Murray County Highway Engineer-"Surveyor's Record Book":

1. No date; "P.I. concrete stone"; no statement pertaining to who set this monument or how it was set.
2. No date; "Located conc. monument 9" below oil mat"; checked with County highway officials and determined date of location approximately Aug., 1975, by County highway survey crew.
3. Oct. 6, 1976; "Placed Conc. Mon. with iron pin in center"; set in position of monument per 2. when road regraded.
