5-6.50 To Marsh Bars N.E. + S.W.  
as certain distance across  
Marsh on line as follows  
Viz Cause flag to be set  
on line between secs.  
16. 21 E of Marsh From  
point where said line  
reaches West edge of  
Marsh 56.50 chs E of  
corner to sections 16. 17.  
20 + 21 I run North  
5.00 chs to a point  
From which flag bears  
 $S 12^{\circ} 15' E$  which gives  
for distance across  
Marsh on line to point  
where flag sets 23.24 chs

S 106 or R 40 W

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Flag sets 100 ch E of edge  
of Marsh.

98.74 Over Marsh bears N + S.

79.96 To point 64 lbs South of  
corner to secs 15, 16, 21 + 22  
From which corner I run  
West on a true line
