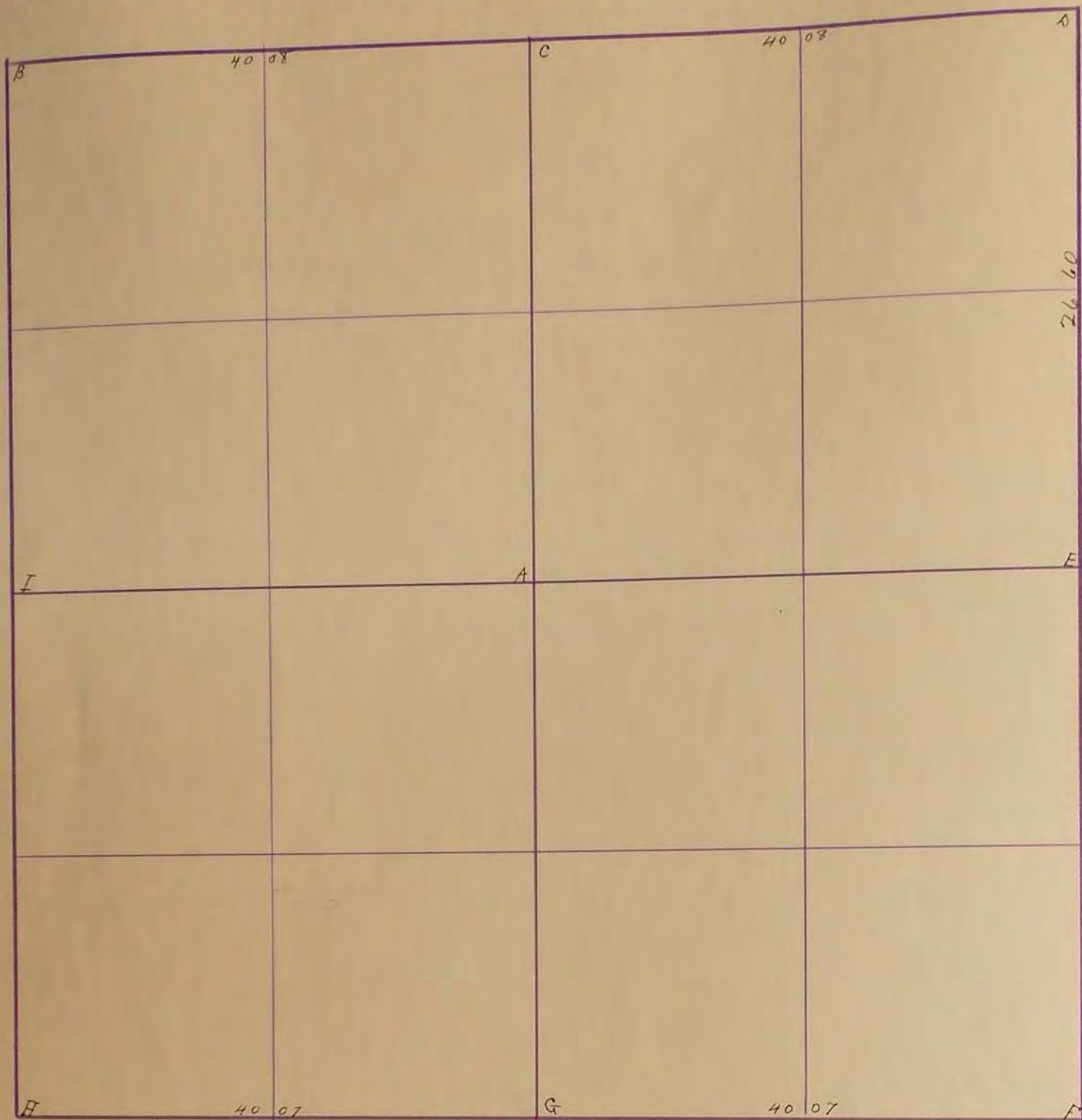

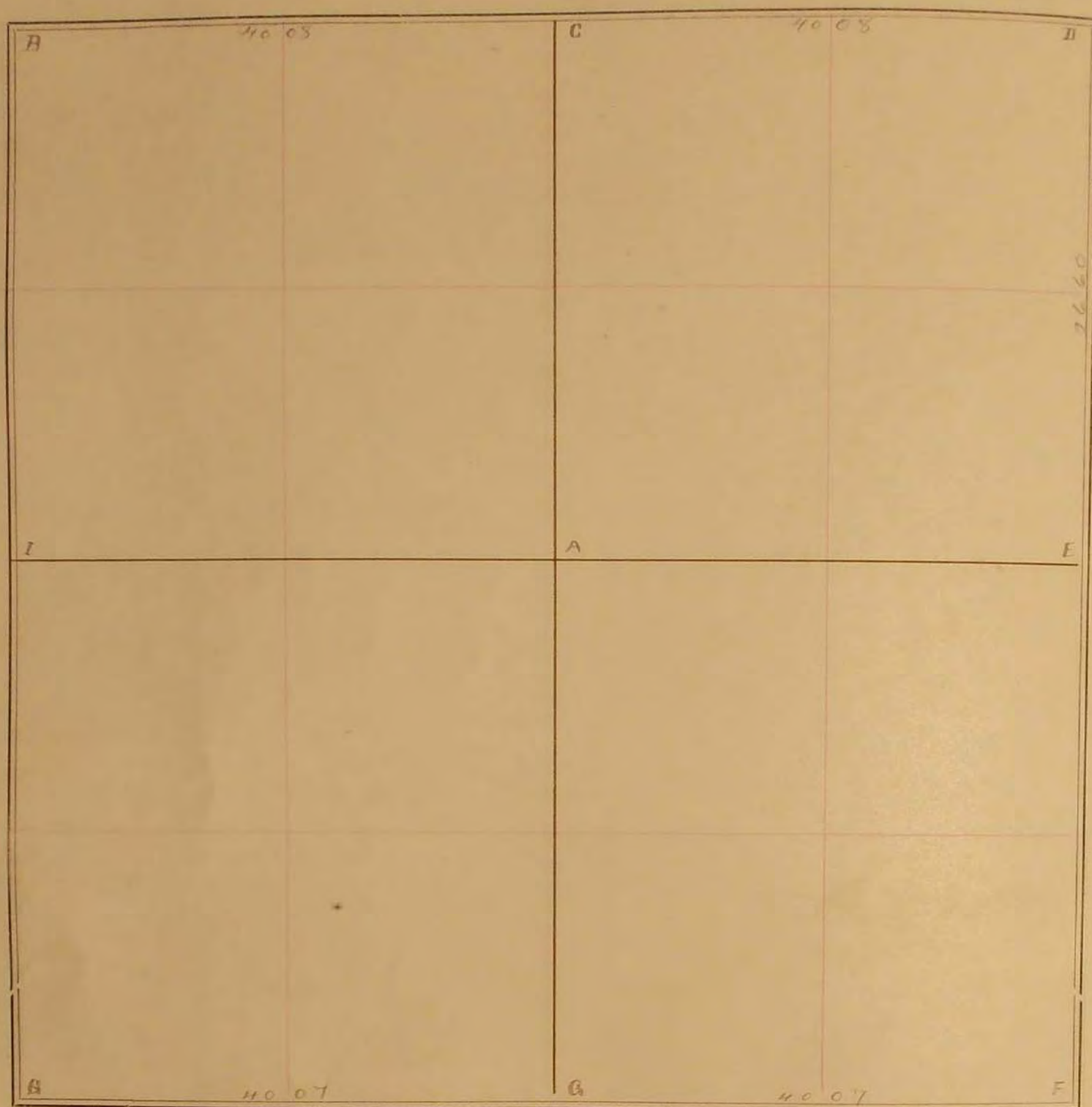
"B" "Concrete Stone": R.P. Tack in Cor fence post SW 46⁶; R.P. Tack in Cor fence post NW 47²
