

Statement of Evidence

East Quarter Corner Section 18, T107N, R39W of the 5th P.M.

In July of 1861, J.W. Myers surveyed the township lines.

In September of 1861, L. Brockmann subdivided the township.

A survey by J.W. Woolstencroft dated May 22, 1901 notes a pitt filled with small stones at the corner.

County records dated June 5, 2012 notes a steel pin with DNR surveyors cap with L.S. #19839 down 6" at the corner.

On July 31, 2025 Bueltel-Moseng Land Surveying searched the area and found a  $\frac{3}{4}$ " iron with a DNR cap with LS #19839.
