

Statement of Evidence

EAST QUARTER CORNER SECTION 19, T107N, R39W OF THE 5th P.M.

In July of 1861, J.W. Myers surveyed the township lines.

In September of 1861, L. Brockmann subdivided the township.

County records dated January 28, 2001 shows Zieske Land Surveying located an iron monument at the corner.

County records dated June 5, 2012 show a $\frac{3}{4}$ " steel pin with an orange survey cap with LS #19839.

On August 27, 2020 Westwood Professional Services located an iron with a survey cap with LS #19839.

On May 7, 2025 Bueltel-Moseng Land Surveying found a $\frac{5}{8}$ " iron with a survey cap with seal #19839, accepted the monument.
