

Statement of Evidence

EAST QUARTER CORNER SECTION 21, T107N, R39W OF THE 5th P.M.

In July of 1861, J.W. Myers surveyed the township lines.

In September of 1861, L. Brockmann subdivided the township.

On August 8, 2006 Perry Zieske, LS #23008, excavated the area and found no evidence of the corner. He set the corner midway and on line between the section corners.

On August 27, 2020 Westwood Professional Services located an iron with survey cap #23008 at the corner.

On May 7, 2025 Bueltel-Moseng Land Surveying searched and found a  $\frac{5}{8}$ " iron with seal #23008, accepted the monument as the corner.
