

Statement of Evidence

EAST QUARTER CORNER SECTION 23, T106N, R39W OF THE 5th P.M.

In September 1858 W.J. Neely surveyed the east township line.

In July of 1861 J.W. Myers surveyed the north, south, and west township lines.

In August of 1861 Wellman & Smoot subdivided the township.

A survey by J.W. Woolstencroft dated November 3, 1912 notes that he used the fence post to the west of the quarter corner as it was online with the corner.

On August 12, 2024, Bueltel-Moseng Land Surveying dug a large hole with a backhoe and found nothing.

On July 30, 2025 Bueltel-Moseng Land Surveying set a $\frac{5}{8}$ " iron with seal #43844 on line between the section corners and in line with fence line to the west per 1912 survey.
