

Statement of Evidence:

East Quarter Corner of Section 24, Township 106 North, Range 39 West, 5th P.M.

- 1859 J.W. Bishop Deputy Surveyor set quarter post in mound.
- 1898 C.W. Gove County Surveyor resurveyed the township and set a 1 ½" x 2 ½" cast iron monument .
- 2025 On November 20th, a Bolton & Menk, Inc. survey crew found the cast iron monument 2.8 feet below the gravel surface. This appears to be the same cast iron as surveyed by C.W. Gove in 1898 and is accepted as this corner. The crew placed a capped iron pipe above the cast iron monument.
