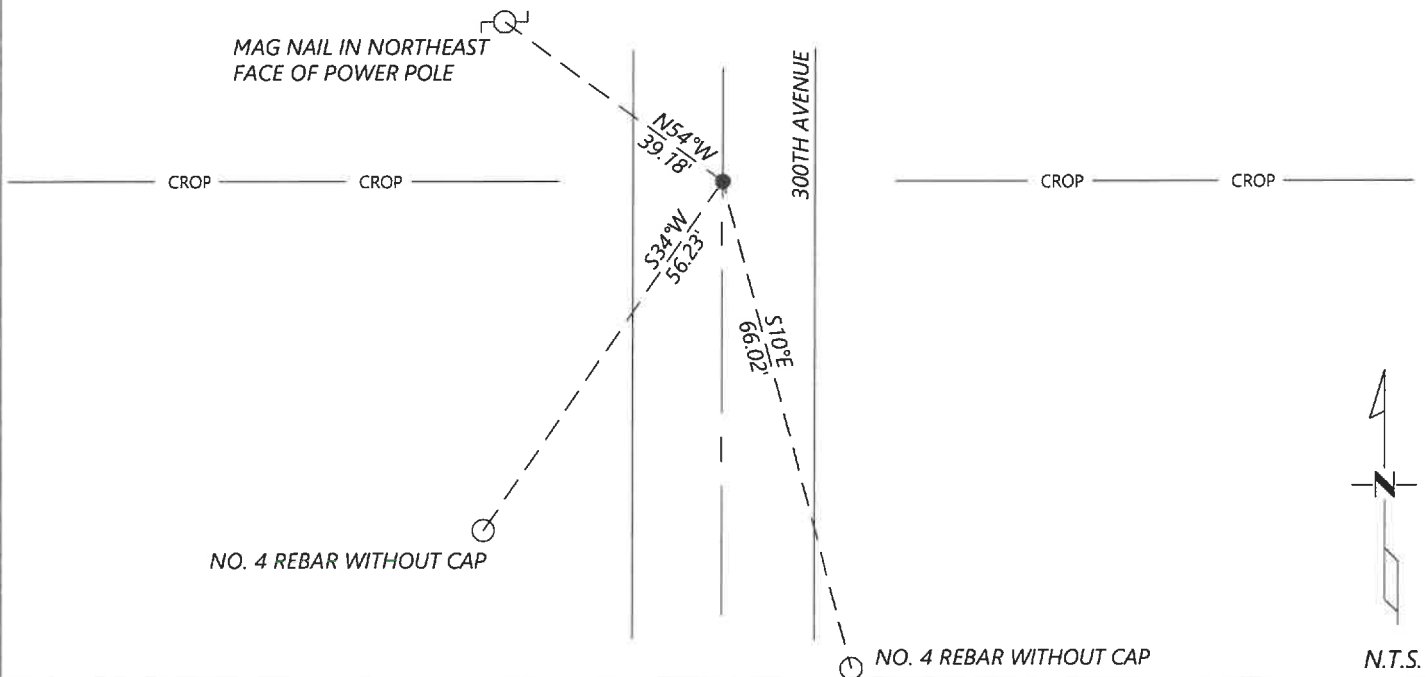

Undated, Survey record for Section 24 shows that the government corner was found. A distance of 2656.6ft is shown to the Southeast section corner and 2655.5ft is shown to the Northeast section corner.

1900 Cottonwood County resurvey shows a distance of 2659ft to the Northwest and Southwest section corners.

2020 September, Westwood Professional Services searched and found a No. 6 rebar, which fits the 1900 Cottonwood County resurvey distances within a couple feet. I accepted the found monument and set new reference ties.
