

## SKETCH OF REFERENCE TIES







Statement of Evidence

East Quarter Corner Section 33, T106N, R39W of the 5th P.M.

In September 1858 W.J. Neely surveyed the east township line.

In July of 1861 J.W. Myers surveyed the north, south, and west township lines.

In August of 1861 Wellman & Smoot subdivided the township.

A survey by J.W. Woolstencroft done in January of an unspecified year notes a government mound and stake located at the corner.

May 13, 2004, certificate by Perry Zieske, L.S. #23008, notes that he found a large stone with a cluster of smaller stones at the corner and placed an iron with his cap over top of the monument.

July 7, 2025, Buetlel-Moseng Land Surveying found 1" pipe with seal #23008 over stone.
