

Statement of Evidence

EAST QUARTER CORNER SECTION 34, T106N, R39W OF THE 5th P.M.

In September 1858 W.J. Neely surveyed the east township line.

In July of 1861 J.W. Myers surveyed the north, south, and west township lines.

In August of 1861 Wellman & Smoot subdivided the township.

A survey by J.W. Woolstencroft done in January of an unspecified year notes a limestone at the corner.

May 22, 2013, Rory Jensen, LS 19789, Bolton & Menk, Inc., set a 1/2" iron pipe with seal 19789 in line with fence line east and west.

November 3, 2025, Bueltel-Moseng Land Surveying found a 1/2" pipe with seal 19789 in fence line running east and west surrounded by circle of stones.
