



Statement of Evidence

East Quarter Corner Section 8, T105N, R39W of the 5th P.M.

In September of 1858 W.J. Neely surveyed the south township boundary.

In July of 1861 J.W. Myers surveyed the North, East, and West township boundary lines.

In August of 1861 Wellman & Smoot subdivided the township.

A survey of section 8 by J.W. Woolstencroft dated July 8, 1896 notes a stone located at the corner.

Survey record of section 8 dated March 28, 1972 notes a lard field stone found at the corner and a steel pin placed at the road surface.

On March 6, 2025 Bueltel-Moseng Land Surveying found a p.k. nail at the location of the corner, it fell in the center line of the road and in line with fence lines running east and west. Returned on October 8, 2025 and set a 3" survey spike with seal #43844 at the location of the p.k. nail after the road over lay.
