
EAST QUARTER Corner of Section 8, Township 106, Range 39, 5TH P.M.

Statement of Evidence

EAST QUARTER CORNER SECTION 8, T106N, R39W OF THE 5th P.M.

In September 1858, W.J. Neely surveyed the east township line.

In July of 1861, J.W. Myers surveyed the north, south, and west township lines.

In August of 1861, Wellman & Smoot subdivided the township.

Undated county records shows a stone located at the corner.

A survey by Perry Zieske, L.S. #23008, shows that he set a gin spike at calculated and occupied position.

On April 9, 2025 Bueltel-Moseng Land Surveying searched the area and could not find gin spike set by Perry Zieske. Dug with a backhoe and found a pointed field stone with pieces of a wood stake by it.

On October 8, 2025 and set a 3" survey spike with seal #43844 at the location of the found stone.
