- 1861 D.W. Wellman and S.S. Smoot, U.S. Deputy Surveyors, during the original public land survey a post was set, drove charred stake and made a mound with trench and pits.
- 1899 J.W. Woolstencroft, survey shows stone in grade.
- 1901 J.W. Woolstencroft, survey shows a stone in road.
- 2009 Zieske Land Surveying (Perry Zieske, LS 23008), surveys shows an iron monument in place.
- 2021 Westwood Professional Services searched the area and did not recover a monument. Lines of occupation consist of a North/South gravel road and a fence line running East.
