

Statement of Evidence

NORTH QUARTER CORNER SECTION 1, T105N, R39W OF THE 5th P.M.

In September of 1858 W.J. Neely surveyed the south township boundary.

In July of 1861 J.W. Myers surveyed the North, East, and West township boundary lines.

In August of 1861 Wellman & Smoot subdivided the township.

A survey dated May 4, 1903 notes a government mound and stake found at the corner.

A corner certificate by Bruce W. Sheppard, L.S. 17003, set a  $\frac{1}{2}$ " iron pipe on line between the section corners and in line with fence line to the north.

County records dated May 16, 2012 notes a 1/2" steel pipe found at the corner.

July 10, 2025, Buetlel-Moseng Land Surveying found 1/2" pipe.
