Undated, Survey record for Section 11 shows that the government corner was not found. A distance of 2649.2ft is shown to the Northeast and Northwest section corners.

- 1963 February, Road plans for CSAH 22 show the corner at station 53+11.48.
- 1991 April, Highway Department records show they they located a $\frac{3}{4}$ rebar and placed an iron pin (assumed) at the corner.

September, Westwood Professional Services searched and found a PK nail on centerline of bituminous road and 2ft west of a fenceline running North. I found 1 tie from the 1991 Highway Department record. The PK location is within 2ft of a prorated distance using the 1963 road plan stationing. I accepted the found monument as the best evidence of the corner location, and set additional reference ties.
