In September 1858, W.J. Neely surveyed the east township line.

In July of 1861, J.W. Myers surveyed the north, south, and west township lines.

In August of 1861, Wellman & Smoot subdivided the township.

June 6, 1995, county records show a $\frac{1}{2}$ " iron with a surveyors cap over stone at the corner.

On June 28, 2024 Bueltel-Moseng Land Surveying searched the area and found a $\frac{1}{2}$ " iron with LS #12967 overtop of the stone.
