



Statement of Evidence

NORTH QUARTER CORNER SECTION 18, T106N, R39W OF THE 5th P.M.

In October of 1857, J.W. Myers surveyed the east township line.

In July of 1861 J.W. Myers surveyed the north, south, and west township lines.

In September of 1861, L. Brockmann subdivided the township.

A survey by J.W. Woolstencroft dated October 16, 1907 notes a blue boulder as the monument.

On October 9, 1991 Bruce Shepperd, LS 17003, searched the area for the stone and found nothing. He set a $\frac{3}{4}$ " iron with an aluminum cap stamped " DNR SURVEY MARKER" on the south side of an old corner fence post.

On November 3, 2025 Bueltel-Moseng Land Surveying found a $\frac{3}{4}$ " iron with an aluminum cap stamped "DNR SURVEY MARKER" at the intersection of the fence lines running east-west and north.
