

Statement of Evidence

**NORTH QUARTER CORNER SECTION 19, T107N, R39W OF THE 5th P.M.**

In July of 1861, J.W. Myers surveyed the township lines.

In September of 1861, L. Brockmann subdivided the township.

County records dated 1963 notes a steel pin was placed at the assumed position of the corner.

On January 28, 2001 Zieske Land Surveying located an iron monument at the corner.

County records dated June 4, 2012 notes a steel pin with a DNR Survey marker with L.S. #19839.

On August 27, 2020 Westwood Professional Services located an iron with an aluminum DNR cap surrounded clay bricks.

On May 7, 2025 Bueltel-Moseng Land Surveying found an aluminum DNR capped iron, accepted the iron as the corner.
