

Statement of Evidence

NORTH QUARTER CORNER SECTION 21, T107N, R39W OF THE 5th P.M.

In July of 1861, J.W. Myers surveyed the township lines.

In September of 1861, L. Brockmann subdivided the township.

County Records from 1963 show a steel pin placed in the assumed position of the corner.

County records from 2012 show a  $\frac{3}{4}$ " steel pin located at the corner.

In September of 2020 Westwood Professional Services located a  $\frac{3}{4}$ " iron at the corner.

On May 7, 2025 Bueltel-Moseng Land Surveying found a  $\frac{3}{4}$ " iron pin at the corner, iron fell in the center line of the county road and in line with fence lines running north and south.
