

Statement of Evidence

NORTH QUARTER CORNER SECTION 24, T106N, R39W OF THE 5th P.M.

In September 1858 W.J. Neely surveyed the east township line.

In July of 1861 J.W. Myers surveyed the north, south, and west township lines.

In August of 1861 Wellman & Smoot subdivided the township.

A survey by J.W. Woolstencroft dated November 2, 1914 notes he found the Government Corner.

County records dated May 26, 2017 show Zieske Land Surveying located an iron stake at the corner.

May 23, 2025 Bueltel-Moseng Land Surveying dug with a backhoe and found a charred wooden stake with a field stone next to it.

June 10, 2025 Bueltel-Moseng Land Surveying set a 5/8" iron with seal #43844 over charred wooden stake.
