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Statement of Evidence

NORTH QUARTER CORNER SECTION 27, T106N, R39W OF THE 5th P.M.

In September 1858 W.J. Neely surveyed the east township line.

In July of 1861 J.W. Myers surveyed the north, south, and west township lines.

In August of 1861 Wellman & Smoot subdivided the township.

On June 28, 2024 Bueltel-Moseng Land Surveying found a railroad spike in the center line of the road and in line with fence to the north.

We returned on August 13, 2024 and dug with backhoe for any other evidence of the corner, we found nothing.

Returned on January 29, 2025 and placed a $\frac{5}{8}$ " iron with seal #43844 in the location of the rail road spike.
