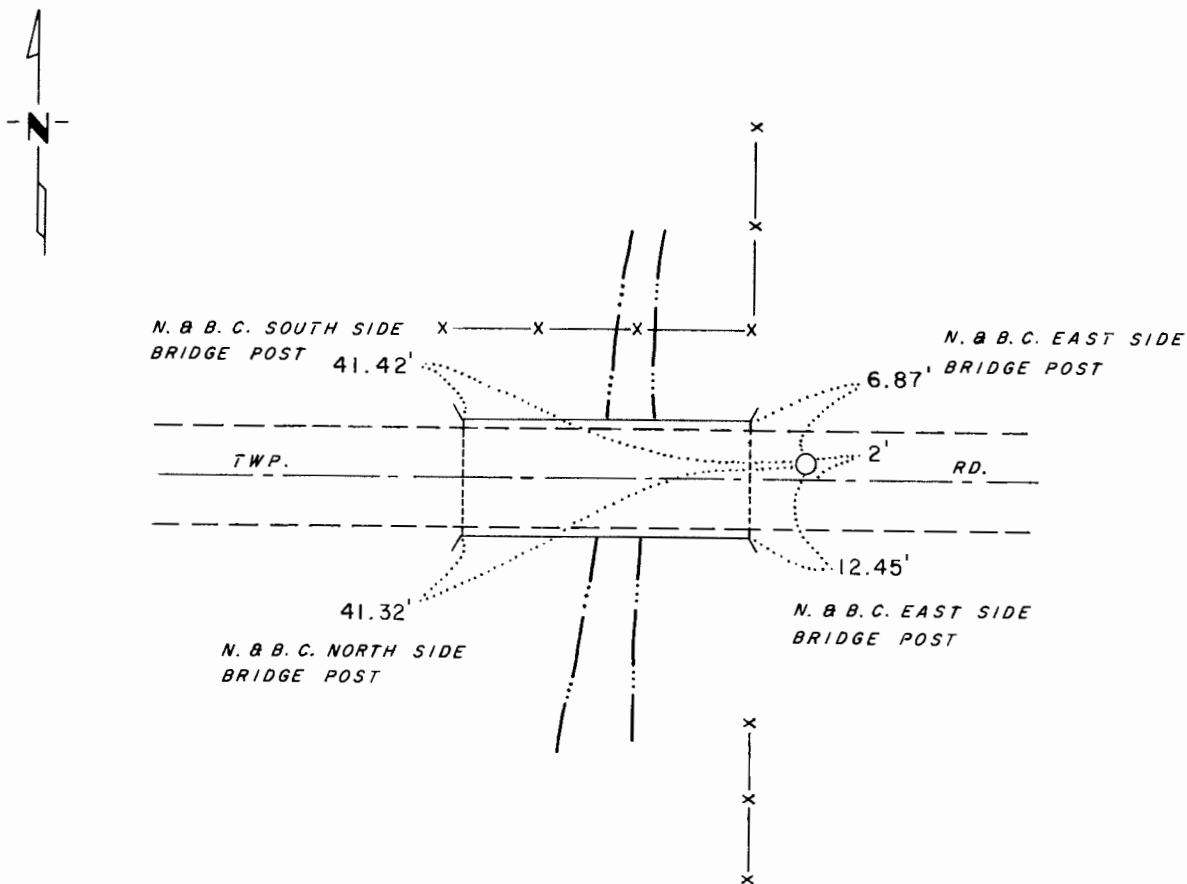

Statement of Evidence:

North Quarter Corner Section 3, T 105 R 41

Murray County

This corner was originally established by the U.S. General Land Office survey in 1861. The government notes show corner marked with a wood post set in mound of earth with pits and trench dug around the mound.

In May, 1977 the DNR Bureau of Engineering contacted the Murray County Offices of the Recorder, Auditor and Engineer for corner information.

The only information found was a survey of Section 34, T 106 R 41 by J. W. Woolstencroft in 1898 in the section book kept in the County Engineer's office. He states this corner was a stake 6' east of a bridge on the north side of grade. He measured 40.04 chains (2642.64) to the section corners both east and west.

The DNR looked for this corner in May and July, 1977. The location of this corner falls just to the east of a bridge, which has been rebuilt since 1898. We believe the stake set by Woolstencroft would have been knocked out at this time. So we established this corner by lost position, midway and on line between section corners. Our distances to the section corners was 2645.43' and approximately 20'+ east of the center of the creek, in line with a fence north, and 2' north of the centerline road. This position fits both the 1898 survey and the original survey. A 1/2" x 14" iron pipe was set to mark this corner.
