
NORTH QUARTER Corner of Section 30, Township 106, Range 39, 5TH P.M.

Statement of Evidence

NORTH QUARTER CORNER SECTION 30, T106N, R39W OF THE 5th P.M.

In September 1858 W.J. Neely surveyed the east township line.

In July of 1861 J.W. Myers surveyed the north, south, and west township lines.

In August of 1861 Wellman & Smoot subdivided the township.

A survey dated June 3, 1931 notes that the old corner was found.

On June 28, 2024 Bueltel-Moseng Land Surveying dug by hand and found a large field stone with a cluster of stones around it.

Returned on January 29, 2025 and placed a  $\frac{5}{8}$ " iron on the north side of the stone.
