

● MONUMENTS FOUND



Statement of Evidence

North Quarter Corner Section 35, T107N, R39W of the 5th P.M.

In October of 1857 J.W. Meyers surveyed the east boundary of the township.

In July of 1861 J.W. Myers surveyed the remaining township lines.

In September of 1861, L. Brockmann subdivided the township.

Survey record of section 35 dated February 5, 1934 notes a concrete stone at the corner.

Survey record of section 26 dated 1967 notes a stone found at the corner.

County records dated May 21, 2012 notes a barn spike found at the corner, could have been an assumed position.

On July 9, 2025 Bueltel-Moseng Land Surveying dug with a backhoe and found a concrete monument with and "x" 0.80'± below the road surface with a $\frac{3}{4}$ " iron on the west side of the monument for locating purposes.
