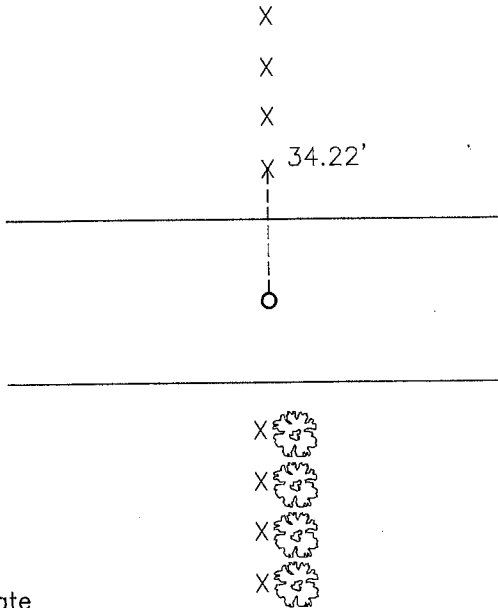

## Statement of Evidence

In 1861, L. G. M. Fletcher did the original subdivision of the township.

On October 24, 1988, Moseng Land Surveying found a field stone at the corner. They set an iron and railroad spike along side of the stone.

On September 5, 2012, Bueltel-Moseng Land Surveying found a large field stone with a "X" chiseled in the top center and a  $\frac{5}{8}$ " iron along the south side of it.
